POSITION SUMMARY

Ontario Health atHome is seeking expressions of interest from physicians with focused practices in geriatrics or family medicine for the position of **Physician Advisor – Ontario Health atHome**. This is a unique opportunity to provide strategic leadership and expert clinical guidance to support the development and implementation of best practices in home and community care. This opportunity is open to all qualified candidates.

The Physician Advisor will co-lead the Clinical Governance Committee for Ontario Health at Home. This role is advisory in nature and does not involve direct clinical care but requires a strong understanding of the home care patient population and the complexities of care delivery in the community. The Physician Advisor will collaborate with Ontario Health atHome leadership, clinical teams, and external stakeholders to ensure safe, effective, and patient-centered care for individuals receiving services at home.

Ideal candidates will be a geriatrician or a family physician with extensive experience in home care or deep knowledge of the community care sector. Experience in other sectors such as acute care or long-term care (LTC) is considered an asset. The role also involves consulting with other medical specialists as needed to inform specialized protocols and address clinical practice questions.
